On Tuesday, February 2, 2010 Native American Resource Partners of Salt Lake City, Utah signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the James Smith Cree First Nation and their development company Fort-a-la-Corne Development Corporation (FLCDC) of Saskatchewan, Canada.

The MOU will provide both parties the potential to jointly develop projects on James Smith Cree First Nation Reserve Lands, as well as throughout their Traditional Territory. This represents another step forward for Native American Resource Partners and the people of the James Smith Cree First Nation.
